Thank you for your interest in Radiologic Sciences at Southern Illinois University Carbondale.

We are very excited to offer the Management/Education Option within the Radiologic Sciences program. This program is delivered via distance education and allows the working-imaging professional the opportunity to complete their baccalaureate degree on a part-time basis.

Any imaging professional may enter the management/education specialization that holds a credential related to the imaging sciences. This includes, but not limited to, radiographers, sonographers, MRI/CT technologists, nuclear medicine technologists, radiation therapists, and medical dosimetrists.

A student may start the program during any semester however; applications should be turned in as soon as possible. To be considered for admission, you must complete and submit all requested application materials for evaluation. **It is very important that you follow the procedures accurately and that your file is completed as soon as possible.** Only completed files will be considered and reviewed.

If accepted and a student chooses to complete an internship as part of their coursework, prior to participating in internships, students may have to undergo a “**Clinic Site Required**” criminal background check and drug screening.

If you are accepted, you must make an appointment with one of our advisors for registration.
